

Community Notification

The Police Department has noticed an increase in door-to-door solicitations in the Township. As a reminder to all residents, the Township does have a solicitation ordinance.

1. Solicitors are required to obtain a permit from the police department prior to soliciting. An example of what that permit looks like is attached to this notification. In addition, it is required that each person conducting the soliciting possess his/her own permit, not just one permit for the company/organization they are representing.
2. Soliciting is only permitted to occur between the hours of 9:00am-7:00pm.
3. Religious, charitable, educational and philanthropic institutions are exempt, but must still register with the township.
4. An individual found to be soliciting in the Township without a permit, will be subject to a \$100.00 fine.
5. As of today's date, there is only one company that has obtained a permit to solicit in 2017 and that company is: Vivint Solar Inc.
6. Individuals posing as a solicitor provides the perfect opportunity for someone to come on to your property and see if anyone is home and to take a closer look at your property. If you encounter a solicitor at your door or on your property, you have the right to ask them to see their permit. If they fail to produce a permit or you feel that they are suspicious, please call 911 immediately and the police will come check them out.
