Spring Beautification Projects

This year we have begun the process to beautify all of the homes within Putnam Village. Some of the work has already commenced, including,



sidelight/door repairs and maintenance and front door and trim painting. Other projects scheduled for the spring/summer involve parking lot repairs, the final phase of flat roof coating, and concrete work. We are also looking into having the rear patios power washed.

Be Aware of your Speed

Please be careful as you drive through the community. Please be aware of and adhere to the posted speed signs on Putnam Blvd and be aware of your surroundings within the parking lot areas. The maximum speed to be driven within the parking lot areas is 10 mph.



Drivers must come to a complete stop at all stop signs. If you have children, please ensure they are not playing within the parking lot areas as well.

Trash Enclosures and Large Trash Pick-up

Please be considerate of others regarding trash.

1. Please do NOT overfill trash bins and crowd enclosures by placing trash on the ground. The trash company is not contracted to pick up excess garbage from the ground.

2. Please break down all trash and recycling and follow the proper guidelines that can be found on: www.putnamvillage.com/recyclingtrash.html

3. Do NOT place large items inside of the trash enclosure. This results in additional fees from the trash company for removal. If a large trash pick-up is needed, please contact CAMCO or Opdenaker Trash & Recycling to assist in arranging this. Failure to do so may result in fines.

Calling all Dog Owners

All dogs must be on leash at all times. Dog owners are responsible for any damage or injury to others.

Exterior Alterations to Your Home

As Spring is finally here, we know that you may want to make some upgrades or changes to your home. Please remember that any exterior alterations, including window replacement, must be approved by the Board of Directors *prior* to the work being completed.

The process is simple – you need an architectural request form, which can be found on the Association website listed below, or by reaching out to Management. The website has specific guidelines to be followed for window replacements and suggestions for contractors that have done replacement work within Putnam Village. Once the request is received it is passed along to the Board for approval or if more



information is needed, we will contact you. You will receive the notice immediately and can begin the work.

Outdoor Guidelines

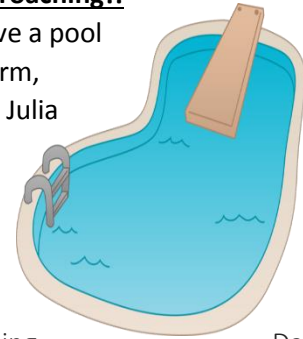
There are outdoor guidelines to be followed that can be found within the Putnam Village Rules & Regulations. Some items that are commonly overlooked are:

- Toys, statuary, lawn ornaments, benches, birdbaths, bird feeders, or any permanent type of furniture may not be placed on any part of the common area
- Unit owners shall keep their units, including deck patios and windows, in a good state of cleanliness
- Window glass breakage, including the integrity of the thermal seal, is the responsibility of the unit owner, and windows in such condition shall be repaired or replaced immediately
