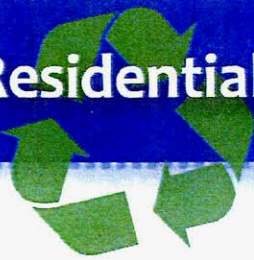


# Residential Guide to Zero-Sort Recycling



**Aluminum & metal cans**



**Plastic food & beverage containers #1, #2 and #4, #5 and #7 with caps removed (not #3 & #6)**



**Phone books**



**Cartons**

**Newspapers, magazines, brochures & inserts (no plastic bags, do not tie & bundle)**



**Corrugated cardboard & Paper bags (flattened)**



**Greeting cards, regular & junk mail**



**Cardboard beverage carriers**



**Paperboard boxes (cereal, pasta & tissue)**



## NO NEED TO REMOVE:

Paper clips, stamps, address labels, staples, metal fasteners, cellophane address windows, rubber bands, spiral bindings, plastic tabs

## NO

- Scrap metal
- Plastic bags
- Plastic lids & caps
- Plastic 6-pack holders
- Needles or syringes
- Plastic microwave trays
- Window panes, mirrors, ceramics & Pyrex dishware
- Plastics other than those listed
- Paint, pesticides, oil & cleansers
- Stickers or address label sheet waste
- Waxed paper or waxed cardboard
- Styrofoam or paper to-go containers
- Organic material and food waste
- Electronic waste (batteries, cell phones, computers, etc.)
- Paper Towels
- Plastic Containers #3 & #6

Please flatten all cardboard boxes. Empty and rinse all containers.
